## **CHRIS BAXTER**

Mr. Baxter graduated *summa cum laude* from Boston College in 1986. Thereafter, Mr. Baxter attended Rutgers Law School and earned his J.D. in 1989 with honors. While at Rutgers, Mr. Baxter was an associate editor of the Rutgers Law Journal and authored a published article on “Free and Appropriate Education” cited in 20 Rutgers L.J. 561 (1988).

Mr. Baxter served as a municipal prosecutor for over 11 years in multiple towns in Burlington County, New Jersey and has significant trial experience at the municipal and superior court levels. He is an Adjunct Professor of Law at Delaware Law School where he teaches a DWI legal theory and practice course. He is also a long time municipal public defender.

Mr. Baxter limits his practice to defending those accused of criminal and DWI offenses, with a special focus on forensic blood alcohol and solid drug testing. Mr. Baxter was recently named a Fellow in the American Institute of Chemists by its board of governors
